WG 24 Co-Convenor Update

Jesse Schneider has informed ISO/TC 197 that he has accepted a position in a new field within BMW, in Germany, and thus has resigned as Co-convenor of WG 24. We would like to thank Jesse for his tremendous contribution to TC 197, as Co-convenor of WG 24. He made important contributions to the development of the ISO/TS 19880-1 and the following work towards the development of the International Standard that will eventually replace the TS.

As per our established tradition, the countries submitting a NWIP have the prerogative to nominate initial and replacement convenors for all active WGs. Therefore, being that the initial NWIP that brought about the creation of WG 24 was jointly submitted by France and USA, we have asked the USA to nominate a replacement for Jesse Schneider. For the interim, we will be counting on the leadership of the acting Co-convenor Guy de Reals, the Secretary Nick Hart, along with the Technical Program Director Jay Keller.

As soon as the USA comes up with an appropriate co-convenor nomination for WG 24, we will proceed with the formal approval by TC 197 via a TAB review and a CIB.
