Approved Resolutions

Taken during the 22nd plenary meeting of ISO/TC 197 on 5-6 December, 2013 in Paris, France

Resolution 360:

TC 197 agrees that a drafting committee for this 22nd Plenary meeting be established as follows:

- Ms. Karen Hall (United Kingdom)
- Mr. Frederic Solbes (France)
- Mr. Jim Ferrero (Secretary of ISO/TC 197)

Resolution 361:

ISO/TC 197 approves the verbal Report of the 21st Plenary Meeting of ISO/TC 197 presented by TC Secretary Jim Ferrero.

Resolution 362:

ISO/TC 197 approves the operational progress review (evaluation of Chair and TAB) as follows:

- Abstain option will be provided moving forward;
- Administrative timeliness will be improved to meet ISO requirements;
- Terms of reference for TAB, Technical Programs and TPDs as outlined in N565 were clarified;
- Secretary role will also be evaluated next term, anticipated in September 2014.

Resolution 363:

ISO/TC 197 confirms the desire to identify the following Working Groups as Inactive, rather than disbanding them for the time being, subject to ISO Central Secretariat approval:

WG 5, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13 and 14.

Resolution 364:

ISO/TC 197 confirms the need for the following work items currently registered in its programme of work, and considering the reports of the working group convenors, agrees to extend target dates after consultation between the ISO Central Secretariat, TPD, and WG convenors, and agrees with the following next steps:

Resolution 367:

ISO/TC 197 approves two new Preliminary Work Items (PWIs) to begin development work required for future NWIPs to update ISO 14687-2 (H2 quality for PEM FC road vehicles) and ISO 14687-3 (H2 quality for PEM FC stationary applications), respectively.

Resolution 368:

ISO/TC 197 thanks Mr. Osamu Tajima and WG 14 members for their work in getting ISO 14687-3 to publication.

Resolution 369:

ISO/TC 197 accepts the application for a new liaison as follows:

Liaison D for ECMA to be extended to include WG 18: Land Vehicle Fuel Tanks and TPRDs in addition to WG 15: Gaseous hydrogen – Cylinders and tubes for stationary storage.

Note: The Chair, Secretary and TAB will review the full list of liaisons and make recommendations to the TC 197 members by the next TC meeting.

Resolution 370:

ISO/TC 197 confirms the composition of its Permanent Editing Committee. The members are comprised of:
