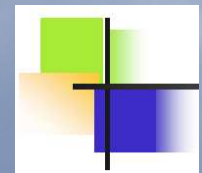

Chair Evaluation Question

Chair Evaluation Comments

- ❑ **Canada's mirror committee** feels that the Chair has done a very good job of transforming and restructuring TC 197 into a well functioning TC.
- ❑ **ANSI ISO Team:** While we are supportive of the structure and intent provided by the Chair upon taking on the Chairmanship, we feel there are areas where reality may not live up to intent:
 - ✓ There has been very little communication, but he is very responsive when contacted.
 - ✓ We were disappointed to see the French NWIP to revise ISO 16111, after the Chair advised the concerns about the UN *Model Regulations*.

TAB Evaluation Question

- ❑ **ANSI ISO Team:** While we do not always see the direct impact of TAB discussions (if they occur), we are concerned about the WG15 situation where there is an obvious conflict of interest.
