Denmark (P-member)	Abstention	Approval	No comments provided.
Egypt (P- to O-member transition)	Abstention	Approval	No comments provided.
Germany* (P-member)	Abstention	Disapproval	There were no substantive concerns with DIS. <u>New technical comments</u> submitted with FDIS vote.
Italy (P-member)	Disapproval	Approval	Italy's key comments were fully resolved.
Korea (P-member)	Approval	Abstention	No comments provided.
New Zealand (P-member)	Approval	Abstention	No comments provided.
Norway*,** (P-member)	Approval	Disapproval	Only 5 comments submitted for DIS. There were no substantive concerns. <u>Nine (9) pages of comments, mostly new,</u> were submitted with FDIS vote. First FDIS comment attempts to misrepresent Norway's DIS position on Annex B.
Spain (P-member)	Approval	Abstention	No comments provided.

\* - Germany and Norway votes appear to be the swing votes: either "Approval" would make the FDIS pass. However, Norway's swing is the most impactful.

\*\* - Norway's change of posture from DIS to FDIS is particularly difficult to explain except by an external influence.
