Our hosts for the 2019 Plenary Meeting Week, AFNOR, have astutely brought forth to our attention the following travel advice.

Significant social demonstrations coincident with our meeting week are to be expected in the general area of Paris, France.

In order to avoid potential train traffic troubles, AFNOR highly recommends that experts modify their travel arrangements to avoid flying to Paris to catch a train to Grenoble from Charles-de-Gaulle airport.

As indicated in N1094, Grenoble is well connected (train, bus, taxi, etc.) to the international airports of Lyon and Geneva, please consider arranging your travel plans accordingly.
